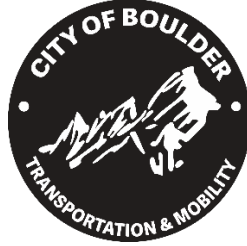


Forest Glen Neighborhood EcoPass Information



Dear Forest Glen GID Residents,

Every person residing in your Forest Glen household is eligible to receive an [RTD Neighborhood EcoPass](#) (NECO Pass). RTD EcoPasses cover all RTD transit services including bus, light rail, and commuter rail. Below are the steps for receiving your free EcoPass:

1. Contact Allison Moore-Farrell at the City of Boulder's Transportation and Mobility Department. She can be reached by email (moorefarrella@bouldercolorado.gov) or phone (720) 564-2368. She will ask for your address to confirm your home is located in the Forest Glen GID.
2. Allison will then email you an RTD Authorization Form for those individuals living in your household.
3. You will take the Authorization Form along with the following items to the Downtown Boulder RTD station located at 1800 14th Street.
 - A photo ID (Driver's License, Passport, or similar government ID)
 - A current document showing that you live at the address (this could be a mortgage statement, a lease statement, a utility bill, etc)
 - Children under the age of 6 ride RTD free and do not need a pass. Youth ages 6-19 receive a discounted fare pass. To show proof of resident for youth, please print the demographics page from Infinite Campus on the Boulder Valley School District website which shows name and physical address.

The RTD employee at the station will review your documentation and print your EcoPass. You do not need to renew your EcoPass each year. It will remain active. EcoPass printing hours at the station have been reduced due to the pandemic. The printing hours are currently Monday – Friday, 10:30am – 2:30pm however it is best to call RTD at (303) 299-6000 to confirm if the hours are changed.
